Described as Britain's finest half-timbered house, Pitchford Hall was owned by the Colthurst family for more than 500 years before being sold in 1992. The tour involves considerable walking and stairs.

Guided tour of Little Wenlock

Join us on a guided walking tour of Little Wenlock led by Neil Clarke. We will see the parish church which houses the county's earliest cast-iron grave slab (1611), the Royal Arms of George IV and the Forester memorial east window; the range of the village's domestic buildings (C16-C20); the historic road pattern; and remains of the industrial history of the area. Tour distance: approximately two miles, duration approximately two hours.
